## **Institute Profile**

R. C. Technical Institute was established at Saraspur, Ahmedabad in 1910 by Rao Bahadur Ranchhodlal Chhotalal (The First Nagarpati and pioneer of textile industry in India). Later on, this institute was handed over to the then State Government of Bombay in 1930 in order to impart and strengthen technical education in the country.

Initially as per the requirement, certificate courses of Mechanical, Electrical, Textile Spinning, Textile Weaving, and Textile Processing were introduced, but afterwards these certificate courses were converted into Diploma Programmes in Textile Manufacturing and Textile Processing in 1947. Considering requirement of additional space, a large and green campus was established at Sola,

Ahmedabad. The new campus was made operational since June 1997. The New campus is situated on S G Highway, in front of New High Court which is covering 19 Acres of lush green pollution free land area. Total built up area is 15224 Sq.M which includes well-developed Class rooms, Laboratories, Library, Workshops, Learning Resource Utilization Center (LRUC), Students' Amenity Centre, Boys & Girls Hostel with mess facility, Staff Quarters, etc. We have amenities like Sports ground, Indoor games, Girls' Room, Canteen, boy's hostel etc. Latest equipped laboratories, well qualified human resources, 17000 plus books in library, 300 plus computer systems with 15 Mbps internet facilities including wifi system for students are some of the key strength of the institute.



Book is the best friend of the students. On April 23, 2016, world book day was celebrated by the Literature Club of the institute. Many books on different subjects including some unique books




were displayed for the students & faculties. The faculties and students visited the book exhibition with great interest.

#### What are soft Skills?

Moss and Tilly defined "Soft skills" as skills, abilities, and traits that pertain to personality, attitude, and behavior rather than to formal or technical knowledge".

Are soft skills important to engineers? Anecdotally, we have all heard of the extremely intelligent individual who lacks the ability to work on team assignments, communicate with clients, or maintain professionalism. Typically, this results in a lack of effectiveness and limits growth opportunities.

In fact, soft skills are as important as engineering skills. Many employers choose to hire skills rather than people. Employers want to select, retain and promote young individuals who are dependable, resourceful, ethical and good communicators who are willing to work under pressure.

Some important soft skills are:

- 1.Strong work ethics
- 2.Positive attitude
- 3.Good communication skills
- 4. Time management abilities
- 5.Problem-solving skills
- 6.Acting as a team player
- 7.Flexibility/adaptability
- 8. Working well under pressure
- 9.Interpersonal Relations & Self-confidence
- 10. Ability to accept and learn from criticism etc.

#### 1. Good communication skills:

Strong communication skills are essential in the engineering and manufacturing field, as you may often need to explain technical information to a non-technical or "lay" audience.

#### 2. Strong leadership:
